**Dear investor..**

The right of the individual who lives in a society to obtain sufficient information from the administration or the authority that governs this society, about the matters that concern him and that he wishes to know, is the true embodiment of the meaning of the right to obtain information guaranteed by the Jordanian Law No. 47 of 2007, Article (8) of which states:

“The official shall facilitate obtaining information and ensure its disclosure without delay and in the manner stipulated in this law.”

Feel free to exercise your right.



# Right to Information

Dear investor..

In order to be able to start a sound investment, it is necessary to collect accurate and correct information related to all aspects of your investment, and to obtain it, it must be collected from its reliable sources. Therefore, you can obtain any information classified as “available” with the Securities Commission by submitting an application for obtaining The information can be obtained either on paper by coming in person to the authority’s headquarters, or electronically through our website, where the Securities Commission has automated the service of answering requests for information in order to be able to request this service electronically by applying directly through the authority’s website through the following link:-

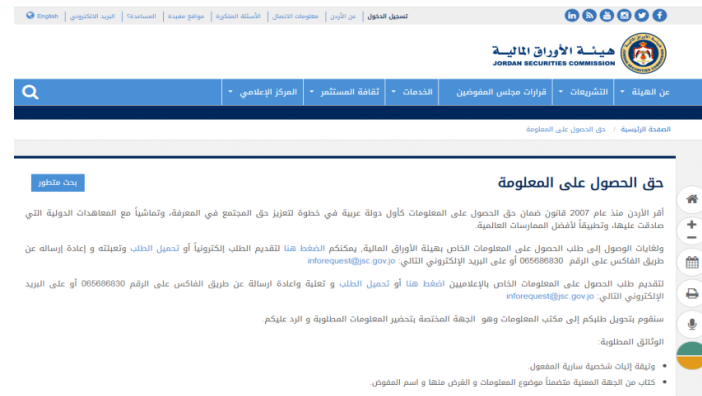



# Right to Information

**Dear investor..**

Be aware that the Securities Commission includes within its organizational structure a special section called the Data and Information Department, which is concerned with implementing the law to ensure the right to obtain information and to answer all inquiries of service recipients within specific protocols and controls with the highest levels of efficiency and effectiveness.

Therefore, dear investor, make sure that you obtain a receipt from the information department when you submit a request to obtain information, and the authority, through its data and information department, ensures the flow of all data classified as available within the policy of proactive disclosure of information.

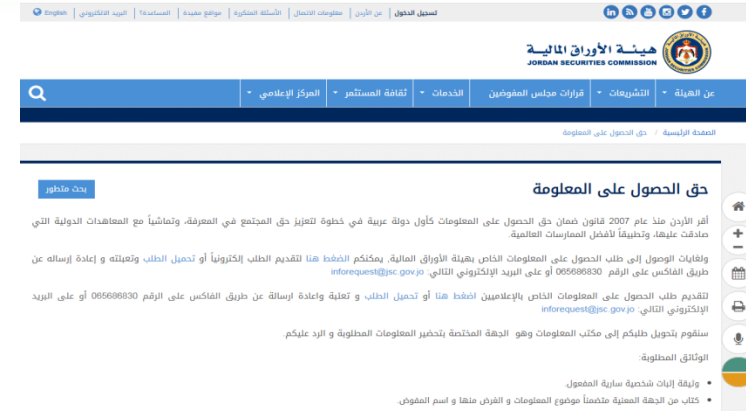


# Right to Information

Dear investor..

Know that the Securities Commission is obligated to respond to requests for information within a period of thirty days from the day following the submission of the request, whether by rejection, which is required to be justified and reasoned, or affirmative.

Also, refraining from responding within the specified period is considered a rejection decision, and thus, dear investor, you have the right to file a complaint Before the Information Council through the Information Commissioner, you also have the right to file a claim against the official before the High Court of Justice in the event that the request for access to information is refused.

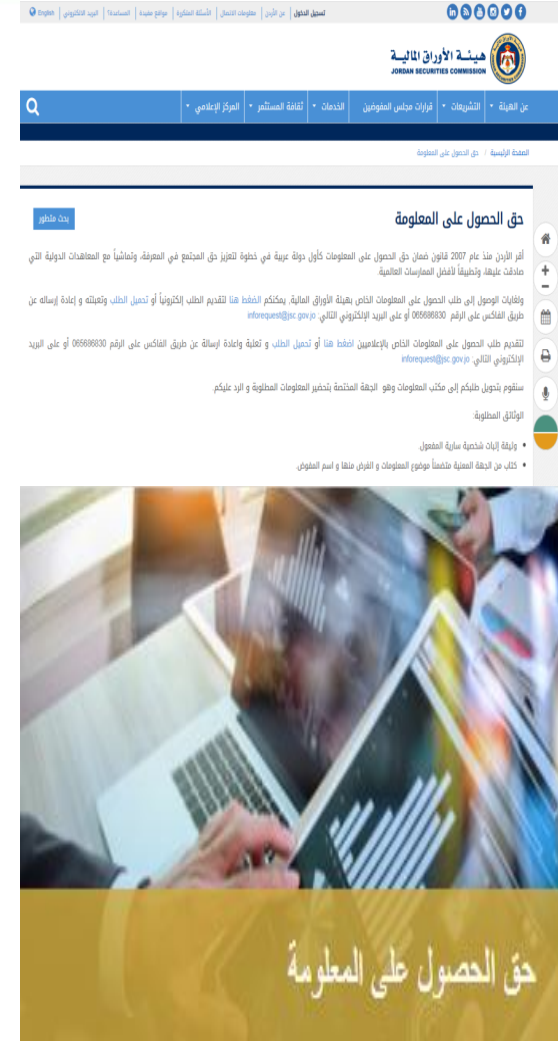
## Dear investor..

The Securities Commission ensures proactive disclosure of information before requesting it from the service recipient.

The Authority has developed a new disclosure mechanism in cooperation with the Amman Stock Exchange through the application of the electronic disclosure system using the XBRL Extensible Business Reporting Language, which is a unified and advanced global language for disclosure in all its aspects.

The application of this system facilitates and speeds up the process of disclosing financial data and non-financial information to the issuers in both Arabic and English, which helps you in providing the necessary information to make your investment decision in a timely manner.

During the year 2020, the authority launched the new XBRL electronic services and disclosure system, which is a platform An exclusive electronic platform for providing services and sending disclosures from entities subject to the authority's control.

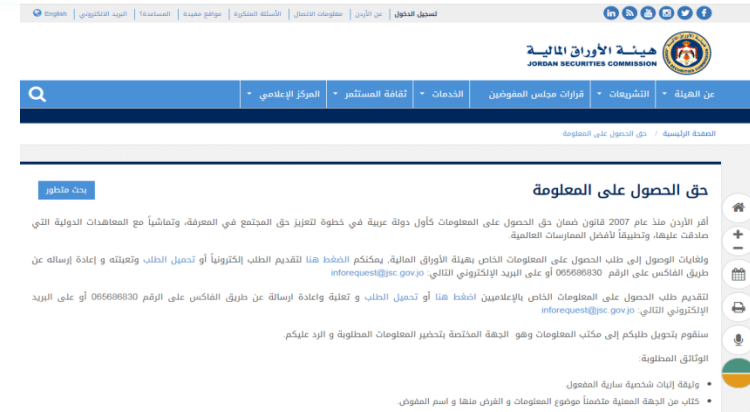

Dear investor,

Be with the know that the Securities and Exchange Commission has finished categorizing its data on the open government data classification platform based on the government data classification policy 2020, with 121 data sets, including 62 groups with a “regular” classification level, 56 groups with a “special” classification level, and three groups with a classification level Sensitive, and there is no group with the authority that is classified under the “secret” level.

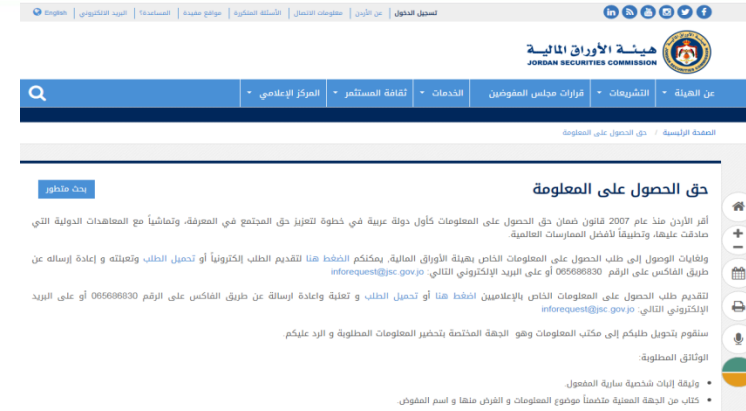
